Communication, Language and Literacy

Threading and Matching



Make a few shapes with paper or card and make a hole in the middle or side.

With a piece of ribbon they can thread the shapes onto the ribbon.

Talk about the colours, shapes, can they make their own shapes? How many can they thread? Hang them up to look at or start all over again. (never leave children unattended)

Buckets and Pegs



A tin or bucket with a selection of pegs is a great way to explore numbers with the children.

They are also using their grip to place the pegs onto the bucket or tin
