Make your own Feely Board

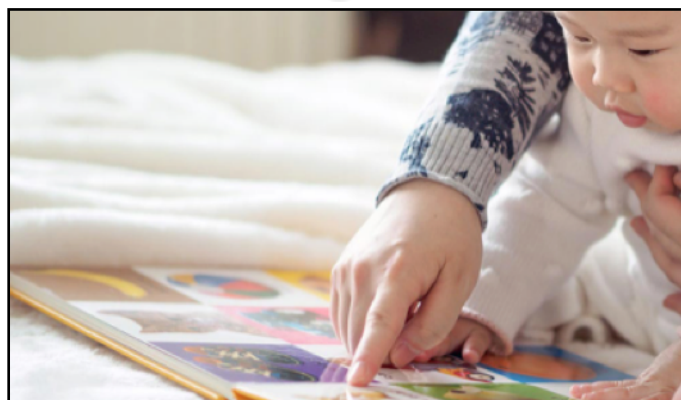


Get creative and make a sensory board, this was made from the tops of baby wipes with different textures.
