

# Ideas for 2-3's

## Communication, Language and Literacy

### Create a collage

Let the children gather some leaves, twigs, pebbles, and create a picture.

Talk about what they have found outdoors,



colours, textures etc, ask them to take photo of their finished master piece.

Always good to look back on photos and talk about what they have been doing.

## Maths

### Getting outdoors



Get on those waterproofs on and go for a walk, look around and talk about what you see.

Look at that big tree, talk about shapes you find Can you spot any numbers, on doors, buses, road signs etc.

Practice those math skills.

## Physical

### Winter sensory play

Add some flour to a tray or storage box and put in some animals, pine cones, twigs etc and create a winter scene.

Let the children manipulate the objects practicing their fine motor skills.



## Emotional and Mental well-being

### Lets have a tea party

Young children love role play and they learn practical life skills such as dressing themselves, how to cooperate and share with others.

Get out real cups, saucers, teapots and talk to your child about how we have to care for these items.
