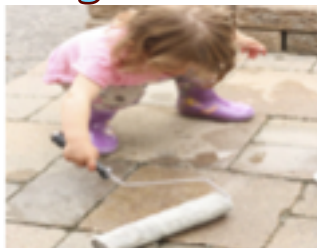


# Ideas for 2-3's

## Communication, Language and Literacy

### Painting with Water



**Really good fun when the weather is warm.**  
Do you have a few paint brushes and a roller?  
Place a small bucket of water outside with the brushes and let the children paint on the floor or walls.  
When the water disappears in the sun talk to them about what has happened to it, introducing new words.

**(Always make sure that children are not left unattended with water)**

## Maths

### Colour Match Chart

If you have a large piece of paper chose some colours to look at and paint them on the side with your child. Talk to them about the colours you have chosen.

Take the chart outside and look around in the garden for items that match the colours. You can even look whilst out on a walk. Great for counting and colour recognition



## Physical

### Painting with your Feet

This is great fun using their feet to paint.

If you have paper and paints take them outdoors and let the children place their feet in the paint or use a brush to paint them, walk along the paper making patterns. Have a bowl of water at the other end to wash their feet and start all over again.

Hang the finished picture up outdoors for everyone to see!!

### Natural Art
