## Communication, Language and Literacy

### Colours and Shapes



Dig out your old jeweller bangles etc and let the children take the lead. Talk about colours, shapes etc. Let the children listen to the sounds of the bangles, you can describe the sounds the children hear...

## Maths

### Problem Solving Skills



Problem solving skills letting the children decide how they will climb in and out of the box, lifting flaps, which way do they go inwards or outwards, watch your children solve the problem as they play.

## Physical

### Experimenting with Ice



Freeze small objects in a container and enjoy watching your little ones dig them out and practice their manipulative skills. This provides a sensory experience for the little ones and the opportunity to practice their fine motor skills.
