# Musical Instruments No.2

## PAN FLUTE



### What you will need

Straws (10-15)

Wool

Strong glue/glue gun (adult use only)

Scissors

Washi tape or sticky tape

Feathers for decorating (optional)

Pan Flute (also known as panpipes or syrinx) is a musical instrument based on the principle of the closed tube, consisting of multiple pipes of gradually increasing length. The pipes are typically made from bamboo, giant cane, or local reeds.

1. Cut your straws so that they gradually decrease in size.
2. Glue together using strong glue.
3. Make a small hole in the straw at either end of the mouth piece section of your pan flute. Attach a length of wool or string, so you can hang the pan flute up. **DO NOT PLACE AROUND THE NECK.**
4. Decorate your pan flute with feathers and washi/patterned tape (optional)

### What you will need

Paper plates

Ribbon, bells or beads

Felt tips or paints

Scissors

A tambourine is a percussion instrument resembling a shallow drum with metal discs in slots around the edge, played by being shaken or hit with the hand.

1. Paint/colour the bottom side of your paper plate with any colourful design, leave to dry.
2. Fold your paper plate in half and glue together.
3. Punch holes every 3 to 4 cm.
4. Thread a bell or bead/s onto a short length of ribbon and tie through each hole.
