## What you will need


Straws (10-15)
Wool

Strong glue/glue gun (adult use only)
Scissors

Washi tape or sticky tape Feathers for decorating (optional)

Pan Flute (also known as panpipes or syrinx) is a musical instrument based on the principle of the closed tube, consisting of multiple pipes of gradually increasing length. The pipes are typically made from bamboo, giant cane, or local reeds.

- 1. Cut your straws so that they gradually decrease in size.
- 2. Glue together using strong glue.
- 3. Make a small hole in the straw at either end of the mouth piece section of your pan flute. Attach a length of wool or string, so you can hang the pan flute up. DO NOT PLACE AROUND THE NECK.
- 4. Decorate your pan flute with feathers and washi/patterned tape (optional)



Paper plates
Ribbon, bells or beads
Felt tips or paints
Scissors

A tambourine is a percussion instrument resembling a shallow drum with metal discs in slots around the edge, played by being shaken or hit with the hand.

- 1. Paint/colour the bottom side of your paper plate with any colourful design, leave to dry.
- 2. Fold your paper plate in half and glue together.
- 3. Punch holes every 3 to 4 cm.
- 4. Thread a bell or bead/s onto a short length of ribbon and tie through each hole.
