garden or when you are out. Mix water and washing up liquid for the bubbles. Fasten a pipe cleaner to the end of your stick and you are ready to make bubbles.


Igniting children's curiosity and developing maths skills.

Playing hoopla will help develop hand eye coordination. This can be played in a group indoors or outdoors.


Play against your parents this will be fun.
