A lovely way to catch the sun outdoors. You can use a large plastic lid, paper plate or cut out different shapes.

Use tissue paper, different coloured paper and let the children rip strips up and stick on the shape.

Carefully make a hole in the top and hang in a tree, fence outdoors and watch the sun shine on the colours.

Talk about the colours, the sun, weather.
